



## Caring for your watch

All J&T Windmills timepieces should be serviced at regular intervals.

To help prolong the life of your J&T Windmills timepiece, we recommend you adhere to the following care instructions:

Mechanical watches need to be maintained on a regular basis.

The mechanism of a mechanical watch depends on the smooth working of the inner movements of the watch. Lubrication of these parts deteriorates over time, resulting in greater friction between these parts which can cause a decrease in accurate time indications. We recommend J&T Windmills timepieces be serviced every two years.

Try to wind your mechanical watch at the same time every day. This is extremely beneficial for the mechanism. You may want to make it a routine, winding it every morning when you wake up.

Avoid setting the day and/or date (if your watch has these functions) between 7pm and 2am, because the day-date mechanism is activated during these hours, and could be damaged if set at this time.

Watches should be cared for with a polishing cloth and stored in the presentation box when not being worn.



## Strap care

Leather straps deteriorate at different rates depending on climatic conditions, sweat acidity and wear and tear.

Your Joseph and Thomas Windmills local agency can supply you with a replacement strap complete with deployment clasp.

## Deployment clasp adjustment

To adjust the deployment clasp on the watch strap, first open up the clasp by depressing the two buttons simultaneously. Once you have isolated the branded bar section, take this section with both hands and pull open the curved branded bar by pulling down on the back plate.

Holding the curved branded bar between thumb and forefinger, with the back plate hanging down, bring the end of the strap round and thread it through the opening. Once you have shortened it to fit, close the back plate by slotting the prong through one of the strap holes.

The strap is now the correct length for you to wear and will not need to be adjusted each day. Instead, use the deployment buttons to snap the strap open and shut each time you wear it. The deployment clasp system means that your leather strap will last much longer and will not crease with continual use in the same way as a standard leather strap would.
